## 2021 Innovative Service Award

The intent of this award is to recognize an innovative service that significantly influences and drives the adoption of sustainability through an organization, customer base, or industry. The Innovative Service Award applies to a company or service provider that can demonstrate having made a significant and measurable impact on Environmental, Social, and/or Governance (ESG) metrics across a value chain. Some Examples could be developing a new sustainable technique or standard, a new structure or business model, or new use of a material or waste stream.

The innovative service must have measurable impacts and include the quantification of business impact (% improvement, % reduction, etc.) for more than one customer and evidence must be provided in the application. Applications should include identification and, if possible, quantification of the direct and indirect benefits outlined above.

Innovate services will vary yet creative and unique solutions are being developed to

significantly advance sustainability across businesses, markets, and industries. We encourage any business with a service they consider to be innovative and drive sustainable solutions forward to apply for this award.

## Award Eligibility

- The business has its headquarters or operations in Wisconsin
- The service you are applying for (or nominating) has impacted company's in Wisconsin
- Self-nominations and nominating others are acceptable.
